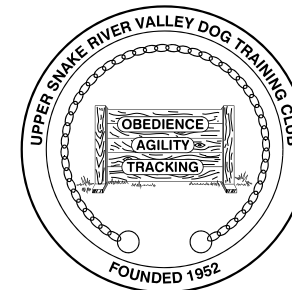

ENTRY INFORMATION

ENTRY FEE is **\$21.00** per event for the first entry of a dog in a Regular Class or Rally and **\$13.00** per event for each additional entry of the same dog. All Non-Regular Classes are **\$10.00**. (Both dogs of Brace considered one entry. All dogs of Team considered one entry. An entry form is required for each dog entered.) Refunds minus \$5.00 per entry will be given for bitches that come in season after the closing date when a request is accompanied with a Veterinarian certification.

Entries close at 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 29, 2009. Fees must accompany entries. All checks and money orders for Obedience Trial are to be made payable to USRVDTTC, in U.S. FUNDS, and mailed or hand carried to Darcy Bartholomay, Trial Secretary, 376 N 3700 E, Rigby, ID 83442. No entry will be accepted, canceled, or substituted except as provided in Chapter 11, Sections 3-7, of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows, *Dogs born after February 15, 2009 for events 2009013904 and 2009013905, February 16, 2009 for events 2009013906 and 2009013908, or February 17, 2009 for events 2009013907 and 2009013909 are not eligible for entry.*

Facilities are **NOT** available for facsimile and/or credit card entries.

No entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone, telegraph, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The club and/or its Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given by the owner or the owner's agent or for entering the dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete. JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The USRVDTDC Trial Secretary has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined except when being judged.

THERE SHALL BE **NO** drilling nor intensive or corrective training on the show grounds or premises. Any training or warm up must comply with Chapter 2, Section 26 of the Obedience Regulations.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

An entry acknowledgment along with a judging schedule will be mailed to the address on the entry after entries close. (If you wish your Agent to receive an acknowledgment of your entry and/or judging schedule, please submit request with entry and Agent's correct address for this courtesy.) Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary by telephone at (208) 745-0492 or by e-mail at idaspud80@msn.com

MOVE UPS

A move-up may be requested from the trial secretary if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request must be in writing or sent by email and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move-ups are to comply with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

The Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, exhibitors, and their property, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these trials. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the trial.

AWARDS

The judge will excuse the handler from that specific exercise, while giving a perfect score for that skipped exercise. The handler may, if desired, do all the exercises, without skipping any, and the score will be marked on all exercises.

The judge will excuse the handler from that specific exercise, while giving a perfect score for that skipped exercise. The handler may, if desired, do all the exercises, without skipping any, and the score will be marked on all exercises.
