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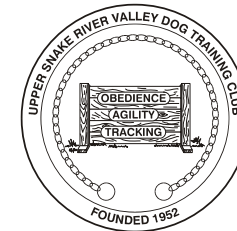

No entry will be accepted, canceled, or substituted except as provided in Chapter 11, Sections 3-7, of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

**Facilities are NOT available for facsimile and/or credit card entries. Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club is NOT accepting online entries. Please mail entries so that they arrive on or before closing.**

**No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. The club and/or its Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given by the owner or the owner's agent or for entering the dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.**

**Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC agility entry form are invalid.**

**Illegible or incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees or a returned check do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Those that have checks returned for NSF will be on a cash only basis for all future trials.**

**Mixed Breed Entries** Enter "Mixed Breed", for "Breed" on the entry form. No other breed description may be used to identify a mixed breed entry. Additionally, provide their AKC Canine Partners listing number on the entry form and check-mark "AKC No." on the form.

**REFUNDS**

**Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in Trials. As such, the club will refund entry fees less \$5.00 per entry per day entered for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate **must** be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

**Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly.

**No entry fees** will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the Trial Committee.

Refunds for cancellations due to judge change, overpayment of entries or cancellations made prior to closing date will be mailed to said Exhibitor or Agent after the trials.

**USRVDT** may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against USRVDT or official thereof.

**DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

Per AKC Rules and Regulations: This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC PAL/ILP number. Dogs born after February 20, 2010 for events 2010013904 and 2010013905, February 21, 2010 for events 2010013906 and 2010013908, or February 22, 2010 for events 2010013907 and 2010013909 are not eligible for entry. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial-giving club is offering the optional mixed breed classes.

**MOVE UPS**

A move-up may be requested from the trial secretary if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request must be in writing or sent by email and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move-ups are to comply with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations.

**JUDGING INFORMATION**

**Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed unless otherwise requested.** An entry acknowledgment along with a judging schedule will be emailed/mailed to the address on the entry after entries close. (If you wish your Agent to receive an acknowledgment of your entry and/or judging schedule, please submit request with entry and Agent's correct address for this courtesy.) Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify the Trial Secretary by telephone at (208) 403-3855 or biogirltjm@yahoo.com

**Check In** will start at 7:30 a.m. Judges briefing will be approximately 10 minutes prior to the start of each class, where required.

PLEASE CONSULT THE JUDGING PROGRAM for time of judging. JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The USRVDTDC Trial Secretary has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Consult AKC's Obedience Regulations and Rally Regulations for specific class information and detail. These trials will follow these rules and regulations.

- No alcoholic beverages permitted in the park.
- No parking on the grass.
- No overnight parking.
- Areas marked as "no parking" will be strictly enforced.
- Idaho Falls, ID has a leash law...all dogs must be on leash except when in the ring or in their crates.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

**SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY**

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club or any official thereof. The Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club will not be responsible for the loss of/or damage to any dog entered and exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is under the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler at all times. The Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club officers, board members, and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, their dogs, or property.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when competing in the ring.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Crating space will be available after 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 19, 2010. Crates may be left overnight. The Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

A food concession is available on the site. The PAW POWER 4H Club will be providing delicious breakfast and lunch items. There are various restaurants and fast food vendors within driving distance.
