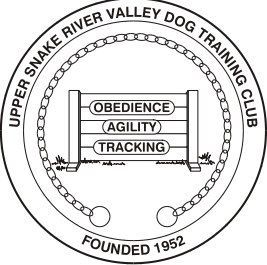

- Absolutely no dogs allowed in any restroom on the show site.
- Reserved overnight parking will be on grass if possible.
- Limited electrical hookups available for reserved overnight parking **ONLY!**
- Long electrical cords and adapters may be needed.
- Mandatory that generators supply power for air conditioner and recreational vehicles furnaces.
- Overnight parking available beginning at noon on Wednesday, June 15, 2011.
- Gates open from 6:00 am till 11:00 pm, Thursday, June 16 through Sunday, June 19.
- **Reserved day parking** is \$5.00. **No electricity available.** Violators will be fined. Parking reservations must be made in advance on form.
- • Parking in assigned spaces only. Parking in direction the parking committee specifies only.
- Reservations close June 1, 2011. No refunds thereafter.
- Anyone wishing to park together must send their reservations in together. No telephone reservations.
- Spaces will be assigned as received by size and space requirements and etc .

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entries not on official AKC agility entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC agility entry form are invalid.

Illegible or incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees or a returned check do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Those that have checks returned for NSF will be on a cash only basis for all future trials.

Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed unless otherwise requested. If you would like to know the status of your entry prior to the issuance of the judging schedule upon closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry. E-mail confirmations will be sent to those listing a legible e-mail address on the entry form.

Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club and Pocatello Kennel Club are NOT accepting online entries. Please mail, email, or fax entries so that they arrive on or before closing.

USRVDT/PC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against USRVDT or official thereof.

REFUNDS

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund entry fees less \$5.00 per entry per day entered for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate **must** be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the Trial Committee.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From North: Travel I-15 to Exit 93, turning east toward Blackfoot. Follow signs to the Eastern Idaho State Fair Grounds, but get in the left lane for approximately 1/3 mile as the road will curve to the left. Go right onto Judicial Street. Travel approximately .9 miles, turning left onto West Main (Highway 91) and stay in the left lane. Go approximately 1/2 mile and you will see fairgrounds on the left. Make 1st left after fairgrounds onto Highland, then make immediate left onto Jones Street following Jones Street for 1/3 mile, entrance is on left.

From South: Travel I-15 to Exit 93, turning east toward Blackfoot. Follow signs to the Eastern Idaho State Fair Grounds, but get in the left lane for approximately 1/3 mile as the road will curve to the left. Go right onto Judicial Street. Travel approximately .9 miles, turning left onto West Main (Highway 91) and stay in the left lane. Go approximately 1/2 mile and you will see fairgrounds on the left. Alternate Route from South: Travel I-15 to Exit 89. Turn north to Highway 91 toward Blackfoot. After 2 miles, you will enter Blackfoot. The road will widen to 2 lanes, stay in the left lane. After approximately 1 mile, the road will curve right then back left. You will go straight through 2 traffic lights. After approximately 1/2 mile, the fairgrounds will be on the left. Make the 1st left past the fairgrounds onto Highland. Make an immediate left onto Jones Street and follow for approximately 1/3 mile, and the entrance will be on the

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. **NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process** When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. However, exhibitors should carry the original valid official jump height card/form at each trial to present upon request. (Chapter 2, Section 4).

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Per AKC Rules and Regulations: This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

MOVEUPS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an Agility title, provided that the request is made in writing (email is sufficient) to the Trial Secretary no later than 6:00 pm, MDT, June 12, 2011. Move-ups from day to day will be allowed, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary no later than at the conclusion of judging on the preceding day.

JUDGING INFORMATION

Electronic Timers will be used.

JUDGING BEGINS AT 8:00 AM MT ON ALL DAYS.

Check In will start at 7:00 am on all days. Judges briefing will be approximately 10 minutes prior to the start of each class.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging, if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. If a VMO or AKC Field Representative is available to measure dogs all dogs without a current height card will need to be measured. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused and not need to stay on site.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Running Order Every effort is made to separate handlers running multiple dogs. Ring conflicts will be accommodated when possible. The running order may only be changed at the sole discretion of the judge.

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

These clubs do not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

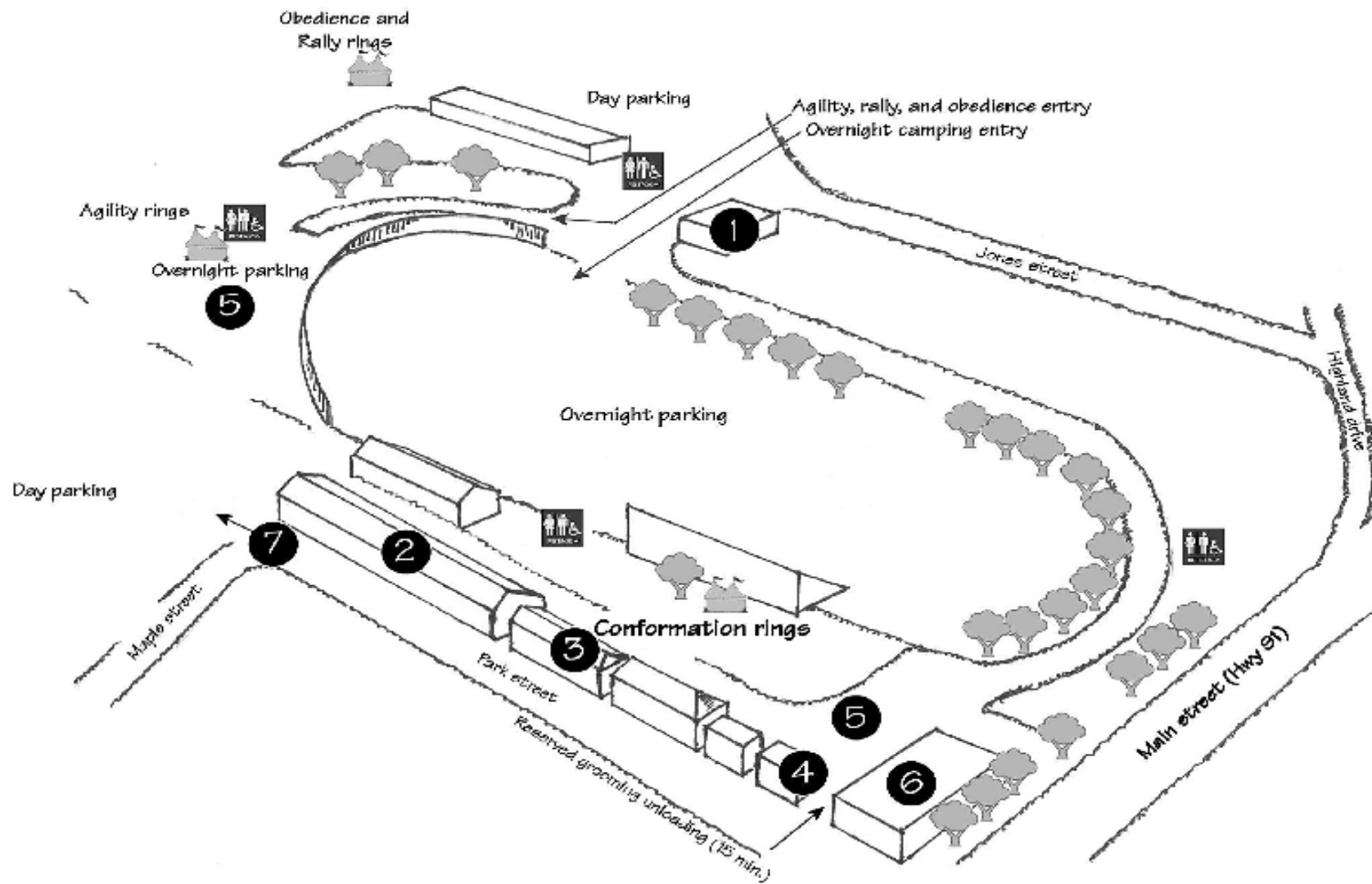
