

Thank you for ordering a Certified Pedigree from the American Kennel Club®. A pedigree contains a great deal of information, and abbreviations are an unfortunate necessity. On this sheet you will find the meanings of the abbreviations used for titles; countries (if a dog was from outside the US); colors and markings; OFA and CERF certifications, and genetic clearance information. Note that if a date is shown after a dog's registration number (such as (01-92)), this is the month and year the dog's first breeding was recorded in the Stud Book Register. *It should not be confused with the dog's date of birth.*

### Abbreviations Used for Titles

The following list shows the abbreviations used for earned titles. Some titles are appended to the beginning of a dog's name, and others are appended after the dog's name. Note that titles earned in a foreign country, or under non-AKC rules and regulations, are not shown on the pedigree.

### Abbreviations Used for OFA and CERF Certifications

**NOTE:** Certification(s) may not appear in the 3rd and 4th generations due to space limitations. Certification by the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals ("OFA") for hips is shown as follows:

"OFA {age in months when certified} {grade}"

where the grade is either "E," "G," or "F" for "excellent," "good," or "fair" respectively. Note that the grade may be absent if the dog passed but the grade is unavailable or unpublished.

Certification by OFA for elbows is shown as follows:

"OFEL {age in months when certified}"

Certification by the Canine Eye Registry Foundation ("CERF") is shown as follows:

"CERF {age in months when certified}"

Note that this certification is only good for one calendar year.

### Abbreviations Used for Genetic Clearance Information

Certification that a dog is genetically clear of a disease is shown as follows:

"DNA ({disease}/{from of disease})"

Example: DNA (PRA/RCD1) denotes the absence of rod-cone dysplasia (RCD1), the form of Progressive Retinal Atrophy (PRA) affecting Irish Setters.

### Abbreviations Used for Countries

The following list shows the abbreviations used for countries from which a foreign dog originated and which appear in parentheses after the dog's name. Note that foreign or other, non-AKC domestic registry registration numbers are shown for a dog only if those numbers are on file with the AKC.
