To: Prospective Class Members,

Our summer obedience classes start on Wednesday, June 2, 2010 at Tautphaus Park. The location is west of the fountain along Fountain View Drive. Each class will be held once a week for eight weeks on Wednesday nights. To enter a class, please complete and return the registration form with fees, payable to USRVDT. Include a copy of proof of Rabies and Parvo vaccinations. The fee is \$50.00 per dog and \$40.00 for a second dog. The fee for seniors is \$40.00. Send registrations and supporting documentation to:

Class size is limited to 20 students so apply early to get the time desired. USRVDT club members must also complete and submit registration forms. **THE CLOSING DATE FOR REGISTRATION IS MAY 22<sup>nd</sup> 2010.** No registrations will be accepted after this date.

The classes being offered and the purpose of the class are as follows:

**Basic Obedience:** This class is for dogs and handlers that have never taken a class. The purpose is to teach the handler to train the dog to a basic level of obedience. It is specifically designed to prepare the handler and dog to take AKC's Canine Good Citizen test. Dogs may be entered in this class (or any of the classes) more than once.

**Intermediate Obedience:** This class is for anyone who wants to achieve better communication and control with his/her dog. It is specifically designed to prepare the handler and dog for AKC's Novice Obedience class offered at AKC Obedience Trials.

**Obedience/Utility:** This class is being provided to prepare handlers and dogs for Open Obedience and Utility classes offered at AKC Obedience Trials.

**Rally:** Rally is a new dog sport that provides a stepping stone from the AKC Canine Good Citizen program to the world of obedience or agility. Rally offers both the dogs and handlers an experience that is fun and energizing. Rally is the first level of three levels and is usually held at AKC Obedience Trials.

**Advanced/Excellence Rally:** This class is being provided to prepare handlers and dogs to participate in AKC's Advance Rally and Excellent Rally classes.

These classes are being held at the times listed below.

Basic Obedience: 06:00 PM, 07:00 PM and 08:00 PM

Intermediate/Open Obedience: 08:00 PM

Rally: 06:00 PM

Advanced/Excellent Rally: 07:00 PM
