DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

Wind River Arena & Stables

The arena is ¾ mile north of Ririe on State Highway 48

From Interstate 15 (from the south and west): Take exit 119 to US Highway 20. Turn east toward Rigby and West Yellowstone. Drive about 10 miles to exit 318 – “County Line Road”. At the bottom of the ramp, turn right. Continue across the railroad tracks to the stop sign. Go straight through the intersection, staying on “County Line Road”. Drive approximately 8 miles to the stop sign, and turn left (SR 48). Drive about ½ mile to the Wind River Arena & Stables on the right.

From Interstate 15 (from the north and west): Take exit 128 to “County Line Road”. At the bottom of the ramp, turn left. Go straight, staying on County Line Road. This road will lead you under US Highway 20 from Hwy 20 to the stop sign, and turn left (SR 48). Drive about ½ mile to the Wind River Arena & Stables on the right.

From Highway 26 (from the east): Take the business Route of Hwy 26 into Ririe. In Ririe, Hwy 26 will intersect State Route 48. Turn left to follow State Route 48 to the west. Drive about ¾ mile on State Highway 48 to the arena on the right.

Note: The driveway is fairly inconspicuous, and the arena sits a few hundred yards off the road, so you'll need to keep an eye out for it. It is the last of a series of gravel driveways before a small field.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entries not on official AKC agility entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC agility entry form are invalid.

Illegible or incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees or a returned check do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Those that have checks returned for NSF will be on a cash only basis for all future trials.

Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club is NOT accepting online entries. Please mail entries so that they arrive on or before closing.

REFUNDS

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund entry fees less \$10.00 per day entered for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate **must** be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the Trial Committee.

USRVDTC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against USRVDTTC or official thereof.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form and exhibitors must be able to present it prior to running their dog(s) in any class or at any time during the trial upon request whether or not they have sent a copy of such with their entry. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Per AKC Rules and Regulations: This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a dirt surface. Ring size will be 100'x100'.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Crating space will be available after 9:00 am on Friday, March 28, 2008. Crates may be left overnight. The Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club and Windriver Arena and Stables will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

A food concession is available on the site. There are various restaurants and fast food vendors within driving distance.

Limited overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. There are limited electrical hook-ups for motor homes or campers available. Overnight parking is \$20.00 with electrical hook-ups and \$10.00 without.

JUDGING INFORMATION

Electronic Timers will be used.

Check In will start at 10:00 am on Friday and 8:00 am on Saturday and Sunday.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging, if a valid copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will not to stay on site.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
