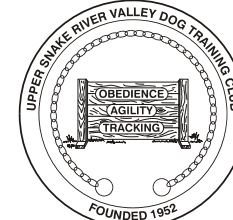

## DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

### Wind River Arena & Stables

*The arena is ¾ mile north of Ririe on State Highway 48*

**From Interstate 15 (from the south and west):** Take **exit 119** to US Highway 20.

Turn east toward Rigby and West Yellowstone. Drive about **10 miles** to **exit 318** – “County Line Road”. At the bottom of the ramp, **turn right**. Continue across the railroad tracks to the stop sign. Go **straight** through the intersection, staying on “County Line Road”. Drive approximately **8 miles** to the stop sign, and **turn left** (SR 48). Drive about **½ mile** to the Wind River Arena & Stables **on the right**.

**From Interstate 15 (from the north and west):** Take **exit 128** “County Line Road”, at the bottom of the ramp, **turn left**. This road will lead you under US Highway 20, continue across railroad tracks to the stop sign. Go **straight** through the intersection, staying on “County Line Road”. Drive approximately **8 miles** to the stop sign, and **turn left** (SR 48). Drive about **½ mile** to the Wind River Arena & Stables **on the right**.

**From Highway 26 (from the east):** Take **the business Route of Hwy 26** into Ririe. In Ririe, Hwy 26 will intersect State Route 48. Turn **left** to follow State Route 48 to the west. Drive about **¾ mile** on State Highway 48 to the arena **on the right**.

**Note:** The driveway is fairly inconspicuous, and the arena sits a few hundred yards off the road, so you’ll need to keep an eye out for it. It is the last of a series of gravel driveways before a small field.

**No entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Entries not on official AKC agility entry forms** or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC agility entry form are invalid.

**Illegible or incomplete entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees or a returned check do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Those that have checks returned for NSF will be on a cash only basis for all future trials.

**Mixed Breed Entries** Enter “Mixed Breed”, for “Breed” on the entry form. No other breed description may be used to identify a mixed breed entry. Additionally, provide their AKC Canine Partners listing number on the entry form and check-mark “AKC No.” on the form.

**Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed unless otherwise requested.**

**Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club is NOT accepting online entries. Please mail, email, or fax entries so that they arrive on or before closing.**

**USRVDTC** may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against USRVDTTC or official thereof.

**REFUNDS**

**Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund entry fees less \$5.00 per entry per day entered for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate **must** be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

**Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly.

**No entry fees** will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the Trial Committee.

**NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process**

### DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Per AKC Rules and Regulations: This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the club is accepting mixed-breed entries.

### MOVE UPS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an Agility title, provided that the request is made in writing (email is sufficient) to the Trial Secretary no later than 6:00 pm, MT, October 25, 2010. Move-ups from Friday to Saturday will be allowed, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary no later than at the conclusion of judging on Friday, October 29, 2010. Move-ups from Saturday to Sunday will be allowed, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary no later than at the conclusion of judging on Saturday, October 30, 2010.

### JUDGING INFORMATION

**Electronic Timers will be used.**

**Check In** will start at 10:00 am on Friday and 8:00 am on Saturday and Sunday. Judges briefing will be approximately 10 minutes prior to the start of each class.

**JUDGING BEGINS AT 11:00 AM MT ON FRIDAY AND JUDGING BEGINS AT 9:00 AM MT SATURDAY AND SUNDAY.**

**Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging, if they do not need to be measured. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will not need to stay on site.

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**Running Order** Every effort is made to separate handlers running multiple dogs. The running order may only be changed at the sole discretion of the judge.

**COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION**

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

**OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS**

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a dirt surface. Ring size will be 100'x100'.

**This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.**
