Our Winter 2017 Obedience Classes start on Wednesday, February 1, 2017, at the 4H Building on Rollandet Street in Idaho Falls. Each class will be held once a week for eight weeks on Wednesday nights. To reserve your spot in a class, you must pre-register and send your registration form to the address listed on the bottom of the form along with your check or money order payable to USRVDTC. In addition, please send a copy of your proof of Rabies and Parvo vaccinations.

Class size is limited and is on a first-come, first-served basis. Registrations must be received at least ten (10) days in advance. Once classes are full, registrants will be notified and put on a waiting list in the event spaces open up.

For descriptions of the levels of classes offered, please see the Obedience page on our website. The minimum age for dogs is six (6) months.

An Orientation will be held on Tuesday, January 31, 2017, at from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., at the 4H Building. (Please note the orientation is not required for the STAR Puppy class or the Intermediate/Open/Advanced class.) Please do not bring your dog to the orientation. At the orientation, you will be able to meet with your instructor. The instructors will go over rules and curriculum for the class in order to save time when the class starts on the 1st. In addition, collars and leads will be available for purchase at the orientation. If you need to purchase a collar for your dog, please measure your dog's neck and also their head at the area just before the ears. This will allow us to provide you with the proper size collar.
