

This All-Breed Tracking Test/TD/TDU is held under American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Tracking Tests by contacting the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Dr, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, by phone (919) 233-9767, by email at <u>info@akc.org</u>, or on their website at <u>www.akc.org</u>. Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry form that accompany this Premium List.

Entry fees include \$3.50 AKC recording fee per first entry, \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog same day. Entry for untitled dogs must include the tracking certification.

No entries will be accepted by email, phone or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Entries not on official AKC agility entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC agility entry form are invalid. In addition, entries will not be accepted without fees or signature. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries.

Illegible or incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees, or a returned check, or a postdated check do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their future entries being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Owners are responsible for any errors on entry forms regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be returned in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. Duplicate entries will not be refunded if already processed.

DRAWING FOR PARTICIPANTS: Untitled dog will have priority for the draw in all tests. If more entries are received than the limit; a drawing will be held on Wednesday Sept. 13 at 6:00 pm at Tautphaus Park near the fountain - South Blvd and Rogers Street. Alternates accepting and present at the test who are not given the opportunity to compete shall have their entry fees returned. No refunds will be given for any reason other than those stated in this paragraph.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. BITCHES in season may participate under the conditions specified in Chapter 2 Section 8 of the Tracking Regulations as amended to January 1, 2016. The test secretary and judges must be notified of the bitch in season prior to drawing for tracks as specified below.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the club, trial committee or trial secretary.

Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against USRVDTC or officials thereof.

<u>Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club is NOT accepting online entries. Please mail entries so that</u> they arrive on or before closing.

JUDGING INFORMATION

TDU Test will start when first track has sufficiently aged Tracking Test/TDU will be held on a university campus and city park.

TD Test will start one hour after completion of the TDU Test. Tracking Test/TD tracking cover will be alfalfa hay fields and fallow crop lands (no grain stubble is anticipated).

DRAWING OF TRACKS Contestants for the Tests will meet at the University Place parking lot. The drawing of tracks will be held promptly at 7:00 a.m. MT.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready when it is to be judged. Neither the club nor the Trial Secretary have any obligation or responsibility to provide a service, through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not available.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER Per AKC Rules and Regulations: The Tracking Test is for dogs not less than six months of age. With the entry form for the TD test of a dog, which has not passed a "Tracking Test", there must be filed a written statement by a person who is accredited by the American Kennel Club to judge a "Tracking Test", that the dog is considered by the judge to be ready for such a test. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog. The holding of other titles including "TD" shall not bar the dog from competition in the TD test. Entries without a Tracking Degree (TD) will be accepted first. There will be no actual scores for the TD or the TDX Test, but the dog will be rated "Passed" or "Failed" and a TD or TDX certificate will be issued by the American Kennel Club confirming all dogs rated "Passed".

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the test site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club, Trial Secretary, or any official thereof.

Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club will not be responsible for the loss of/or damage to any dog entered and exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is under the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler at all times. Upper Snake River Valley Dog Training Club, Club officers, board members, and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, their dogs, or property.

An Idaho shaped plaque will be awarded to all dogs passing the TD/TDU test.

All dogs must be on leash at all times or otherwise confined when on test sites.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

There will be no food vendor on site. There are several restaurants and fast food establishments within driving distance. Some food and beverages will be provided by the club. Please provide for your own needs.

There is NO overnight parking allowed at the test sites.
